



Arizona renewable energy proposition

Proposition 127, a ballot initiative to require Arizona utilities to generate 50 percent of their electricity through renewable energy sources such as solar and wind by 2030, will appear on the ballot this November after the Arizona Supreme Court dismissed a challenge to the signatures gathered for the petition.

The legislation is connected to Proposition 127, a ballot initiative in Arizona. The ballot initiative, called the Arizona Renewable Energy Standards Initiative (or "Clean Energy for Healthy Arizona"), will likely appear on the Arizona general election ballot on November 6, 2018 as an initiated constitutional amendment.

Arizona is known for its stunning landscapes and natural wonders from the Grand Canyon in the north to the Saguaro deserts in the south. 1 The state has few fossil fuel reserves, but it does have abundant renewable energy resources. 2,3,4,5 Although higher elevations receive greater amounts of precipitation, including significant snowfalls, most of Arizona is ...

sufficiency through renewables and energy storage. o Arizona was the first U.S. state, in 2006, to require utilities to get a certain percentage of their power from renewable resources, specifically 15 percent by 2025. o AND YET, Arizona presently falls last among its neighbors in terms of renewables mandate.

What other ballot measures were related to energy policies in 2018? In 2018, voters in Arizona, Nevada, and Washington decided ballot initiatives designed to reduce the use of fossil fuels and increase the use of renewable resources. Arizona and Nevada, the environmental organization NextGen Climate Action was financing ballot initiatives, Arizona Proposition 127 and Nevada ...

Arizona residents will be able to vote on Proposition 127 on Nov. 6, 2018. Ronald Roedel, a professor emeritus at the School for Engineering of Matter, Transport and Energy, who deals with solar policy, said the legislation is affecting how students are taught solar policy at ASU.
