

# Average price of solar system

The representative residential PV system (RPV) for 2024 has a rating of 8 kW dc (the sum of the system's module ratings). Each module has an area (with frame) of 1.9 m<sup>2</sup> and a rated power of 400 watts, corresponding to an efficiency of 21.1%. Solar panel installation costs a national average of \$16,500 for a 6kW solar panel system for a 1,500 square ft. home. The price per watt for solar panels can range from \$2.50 to \$3.50, and largely depends on the home's geographical area. Residential solar panels are usually sized at 3kW to 8kW and can cost anywhere from \$9,255 and \$28,000 in total installation costs.

Cost of the solar system. This goes without saying; solar panels can cost \$5,000, \$10,000, \$20,000, or even \$50,000, depending primarily on the size of the solar system you're about to install, and secondarily on the brand, location, contractors, and so on. The average 8 kW solar system will cost about \$16,800, including the 30% federal solar tax credit. An 8 kW solar panel system will generate somewhere between 700 kWh and 1,400 kWh of electricity per month, depending on how much sunlight your roof gets.

**The True Cost of Solar.** The factors that make up how much it costs to install a solar panel system fall into two general categories of hardware costs and soft costs. Hardware costs include the actual equipment that make up a solar panel system: panels, solar inverters, mounting hardware, wiring and potentially, home batteries.

As of January 2022, the average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$2.77 per watt (\$11,080 for a 4 kW solar system). That means the total cost for a 4,000-watt solar system would be \$8,200 after the 26% federal tax credit discount (not factoring in any additional state rebates or incentives).

How much does an average 10kW solar system cost? As of January 2024, a 10kW solar energy system will cost about \$30,000 before incentives, based on the average cost of solar in the U.S. When you take the federal tax credit into account, that price drops to about \$21,000.. It's important to keep in mind that solar system pricing varies from state to state.

The average U.S. solar shopper needs about 11 kilowatts (kW) of home solar to cover their electricity usage. Based on thousands of quotes in the EnergySage Marketplace, you'll pay about \$20,948 to install a system around that size in 2024 after federal tax credits.
