The company's name is identical to that of a UK-based consulting firm, which has been mistaken for the San Francisco-based cloud startup Solid8. The UK company has been fielding angry messages intended for Lofthouse's tech firm. In a statement to Business Insider, Solid8 Consulting managing director Emma Jones said:

Where is solid8 based?

Solid8's LinkedIn profile lists 650 California Street in San Francisco as the company's primary address, an address that is also listed as a WeWork coworking space. A screenshot from a Google search last week shows a result for Lofthouse's LinkedIn profile. It's unclear if the startup has received any sort of venture funding.

Is solid8 a cloud transformation expert?

Solid8 bills itself as "Silicon Valley Cloud Transformation Experts" that implement UCaaS, CCaaS, SDWAN, Security, Colocation Datacenter Services, Managed Hosting, and DRaaS, but doesn't identify on its website any vendor partners. The company, which had an established website, changed its homepage over the weekend with the message "coming soon."
