Why are pumped storage stations important?

Greater levels of intermittent renewables on energy systems around the world will make pumped storage all the more vital in helping to balance grids. Their mountainous locations also make pumped storage stations some of the most dramatic and interesting monuments in energy.

What is a pumped-storage power plant?

Pumped-storage power plants were first developed in the 1970s to improve the way major thermal and nuclear power plants dealt with widely fluctuating demand for electricity at different times of the day. How do pumped storage power plants work?

Pumped-storage power plants store electricity using water from dams. The new model for using the plants in combination with renewable energy has led to a revival of the technology. In 2000, there were around 30 pumped storage power plants with a capacity of more than 1,000 megawatts worldwide.

Can a pumped storage power station help a solar power plant?

The same can be applied to solar generation: the pumped storage power station can contribute to constant electricity production at night time when there is no sunshine to run a solar power plant. The flexibility extends not just to the turbine and tank sizes, but also to the depth the system is installed at.

The Rocky Mountain Pumped Storage project in Rome, Georgia is the last utility grade pumped storage project constructed in the US. Completed in 1996, and generating 848MW of hydroelectric power from three reversible pump/turbine-motor/generator units, an upgrade is currently underway to increase generating capacity to approximately 1050MW.

A risky investment uses a higher discount rate. Almost all the costs of a pumped hydro system are up front, similar to a solar or wind power station, but unlike a gas power station where most of the costs are for fuel. A typical real (after subtracting inflation) discount rate for a low-risk investment is 5%.

China has set a new global benchmark in the global hydropower sector with the completion of the Fengning Pumped Storage Power Station, the largest of its kind in the world. Thus, pumped storage plants can operate only if these plants are interconnected in a large grid. Principle of Operation. The pumped storage plant is consists of two ponds, one at a high level and other at a low level with powerhouse near the low-level pond. The two ponds are connected through a penstock. The pumped storage plant is shown in fig. 1.

Pumped storage power plant works on the principle of balancing the load demand of the electricity system. During peak hours, when the demand for electricity is high, water is discharged through pressure pipes from the reservoir above, turn turbines to generate electricity on the system, the water is stored in the reservoir below. ...
