How to choose a UPS battery backup for a desktop PC?

By installing the UPS manufacturer's drivers/app, Windows now knows what this device is and will stop treating it like a generic battery. Hence, the battery icon will go away in the taskbar and you won't have to mess with unneeded settings.

Windows 10 and Windows 11 enable fast startup as a default setting during installation. If you enable fast startup, your computer doesn't completely shut down. Instead, it enters a middle ground that combines a full shutdown with hibernation mode, saving the last machine state to enable you to start working straight away.
