Does home depot recycle batteries?

The Home Depot has partnered with Call2Recycle, a nonprofit battery recycling program. Rechargeable batteries can be dropped off in Call2Recycle bins at the store. Any rechargeable battery that weighs up to 11 pounds and is under 300 watt hours is accepted. There's no charge for recycling.

Can you recycle alkaline batteries at Home Depot?

Most places don't accept single-use alkaline batteries for recycling. You can't take single-use batteries to Call2Recycle drop-off sites at The Home Depot. In most places, you can put alkaline batteries, such as AA, AAA and D batteries, in the trash. They can be carried out to the curb with the rest of your household garbage.

How do you recycle batteries at Home Depot?

Bring your batteries to your local Home Depot store and locate the Call2Recycle collection bin, usually found near the front entrance or returns desk. Place your batteries in the bin, which can also accept batteries from other manufacturers at no cost to you. That's it - Home Depot takes care of the rest!

Can rechargeable batteries be recycled?

Rechargeable batteries can be recycled. Look for the battery recycling seals on rechargeable batteries. Recycling companies dispose of the components of rechargeable batteries properly. The metals and chemicals don't end up in streams and landfills. The Home Depot has partnered with Call2Recycle, a nonprofit battery recycling program.

Can you put batteries in the trash at Home Depot?

You can't take single-use batteries to Call2Recycle drop-off sites at The Home Depot. In most places, you can put alkaline batteries, such as AA, AAA and D batteries, in the trash. They can be carried out to the curb with the rest of your household garbage. Many landfills will also accept trash bags that contain alkaline batteries.

Where can I recycle a rechargeable battery?

Batteries must be brought to a household hazardous waste disposal facility. Another option is recycling at an authorized recycling facility in the state. Rechargeable batteries can be charged hundreds of times before they have to be replaced. Laptops, tablets, digital cameras, cell phones and cordless power tools all use rechargeable batteries.

The program is free to residents and accepts Lithium Ion (Li-ion), Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel-Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), and Nickle Zinc (Ni-ZN) as well as small lead-acid batteries.
