How do I dispose of my Ryobi battery?

It is essential to follow their guidelines regarding drop-off locations, operating hours, and any additional requirements. Do not dispose of in regular trash or recycling bins: Never throw your Ryobi battery in the regular trash or recycling bins. Batteries can contaminate the environment and cause harm if not disposed of correctly.

Can you recycle a Ryobi battery?

When the batteries fail to charge or you no longer have a need for the tool that the battery pack goes with, you can recycle the batteries to keep them from ending up in a landfill. Find a place to recycle your Ryobi battery on Call2Recycle (see Resources).

Does Ryobi have a rechargeable battery program?

Ryobi, unfortunately, doesn't have this type of program available. Ryobi manufacturers power tools that come with rechargeable battery packs. The battery packs are infused with Lithium-Ion batteries. Although these batteries are rechargeable, they don't last forever.

How do I remove a Ryobi battery?

Turn off the device: Make sure that the device powered by the Ryobi battery is turned off and unplugged. This will prevent any electric shocks or accidents during the removal process. Locate the battery compartment: Depending on the device, the battery compartment may be located on the side, bottom, or back.

How do I dispose of a battery?

The first step is to work out what type of battery you're disposing of. This should be written clearly on the side of the cell (or the top of the cell, in the case of button or coin batteries). Look for descriptors like "alkaline," "lead-acid," "lithium," "nickel cadmium," and others since not all recycling locations accept all types of batteries.

Where can I recycle a dead battery?

Call2Recycle is one of the companies that offer mail-in battery recycling kits. The kit comes with a container that you can use to collect dead single-use batteries. When the container gets full, you can mail your alkaline batteries to a recycling center.

You can recycle many types of household batteries at B-cycle drop-off locations around NSW. Accepted batteries include: standard size handheld batteries including AA, AAA, C, D, 9V, 6V and lantern batteries; button batteries used in hearing aids, remote controls and watches; standard size handheld rechargeable batteries of all chemistry types

If you can remember who you got the battery from in the first place, you can contact them and dispose of the battery. Since 2010, any shop that sold more than 32KG a year would have to provide some kind of store collection for the batteries to make it easy for the customer to dispose of these batteries on their own.

When preparing lithium primary batteries for recycling, always cover the electrical connections or battery terminals with a non-conductive tape (electrical or vinyl) or seal individual batteries in separate plastic bags so they cannot conduct electricity. This helps eliminate potential fire or explosion hazards when batteries are collected in a ...

Non-leaking batteries can be dropped off in Call2Recycle bins at the store. Place your batteries in the plastic bags provided and drop them in the bin. There is no charge for recycling. Instead, EPA recommends that all household lithium batteries be dropped off at battery collection sites (e.g., often located at electronics retailers) or household hazardous waste collection facilities for proper management. Store batteries in a cool, dry place such as a plastic container. If the batteries are physically damaged, store them in an insulated plastic bag to avoid any short-circuiting. Recycle your batteries in a local battery drop-off bin or at a recycling centre. What to avoid when recycling lithium-ion batteries:
