



# How to install photovoltaic solar panels

Solar panels could reduce your bills and even earn money by generating electricity you can sell back to your energy company. But the average solar panel system of 3.5kWp will cost around £7,000 to install, according to estimates from the Energy Saving Trust.

**Solar panel racking and mounting installation** For roof-mount kits, the first step is to mark the location of your roof rafters. These support beams will act as the foundation for your solar array. If your rafters aren't visible from the outside, you can buy a stud finder or measure their location from the inside of your attic.

The required wattage by Solar Panels System =  $1480 \text{ Wh} \times 1.3$  ... (1.3 is the factor used for energy lost in the system) =  $1924 \text{ Wh/day}$ . Finding the Size and No. of Solar Panels. W Peak Capacity of Solar Panel =  $1924 \text{ Wh} / 3.2 = 601.25 \text{ W Peak}$ . Required No of Solar Panels =  $601.25 / 120\text{W}$ . The ideal roof for a residential solar system has 500 sq ft (46 m<sup>2</sup>) of unobstructed, south-facing, unshaded space, sloped at a 30-degree pitch.
