Pumped hydro storage is the most-deployed energy storage technology around the world, according to the International Energy Agency, accounting for 90% of global energy storage in 2020. 1 As of May 2023, China leads the world in operational pumped-storage capacity with 50 gigawatts (GW), representing 30% of global capacity. 2

According to the IEA, while the total capacity additions of nonpumped hydro utility-scale energy storage grew

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to slightly over 500 MW in 2016 (below the 2015 growth rate), nearly 1 GW of new utility-scale stationary energy storage capacity was announced in the second half of 2016; the vast majority involving lithium-ion batteries. 8 Regulatory ...

Total installed grid-scale battery storage capacity stood at close to 28 GW at the end of 2022, most of which was added over the course of the previous 6 years. Compared with 2021, installations rose by more than 75% in 2022, as around 11 GW of storage capacity was added.

The choice of storage duration will depend on the specific application and the customer's energy needs. For example, a residential ESS may require only a few hours of storage capacity to provide backup power during a grid outage, while a utility-scale ESS may require several days of storage capacity to support a large renewable energy project.
