As electricity storage is a relatively undeveloped field in Poland, there are still no detailed acts in Polish law which refer to it. However, the Renewable Energy Sources Act ("RES Act") defines an electricity storage facility as a dedicated facility or group of facilities where electric energy generated as a result of technological or chemical processes is stored in a different form.

The energy from the storage would be injected when there is a shortage of energy on the grid and the price is high, helping to balance the energy system. On 15 April 2021, the Polish Parliament in the Lower Chamber (Sejm) adopted a draft amendment to the Energy Law Act ("Draft"). The new provisions introduce comprehensive solutions for the development of energy storage facilities in Poland and are aimed at eliminating certain barriers to the expansion of this technology in Poland. Harmonisation of definitions of "energy storage" and "energy storage systems" in the draft solves interpretation problems stemming from inconsistencies in these definitions across different legal acts. Redefinition of an "end user" made it possible to exclude energy used for energy storage purposes from the end consumption category.

PGE is also developing a battery energy storage facility at the Żarnowiec pumped storage power plant (southern Poland) with a capacity of at least 200 MW and a storage capacity of over 820 MWh, planned for commissioning in 2027. By 2030, the company aims to have at least 0.8 GW of new energy storage capacity.

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
