

Power bi workspace backup

Does Power BI support workspace-level storage?

Workspace-level storage, which is helpful when business units manage their own data lake or have certain data residency requirements. Backup and restore for Power BI semantic models: The Power BI semantic model backup and restore feature is supported for workspaces that are assigned to capacity or PPU.

How does Power BI backup a workspace?

Power BI associates workspaces with their backup directories based on the workspace name. With owner permissions at the storage account level, you can download backup files or copy them from their original location to the backup directory of a different workspace, and restore them there if you're a workspace admin in the target workspace as well.

Does Power BI support backup and restore?

Backup and restore for Power BI semantic models: The Power BI semantic model backup and restore feature is supported for workspaces that are assigned to capacity or PPU. This feature uses the same ADLS Gen2 account that's used for storing Power BI dataflows data (described in the previous bullet point).

How to backup data from Power BI workspace to ADLs Gen2?

On the Power BI Workspace, you need to be a workspace administrator to configure the workspace connection to ADLS gen2. To perform backups, you must be admin, member, or contributor to the workspace. Restore backups to existing datasets, you must be owner of the dataset.

What happens if I rename a workspace in Power BI?

If you rename a workspace, the backup folder in the power-bi-backup container is automatically renamed to match. However, if you have an existing folder with the same name as the renamed workspace, the automatic renaming for the backup folder fails. When using the Backup and Restore feature with Power BI, keep the following in mind.

What is a Power BI workspace?

This workspace is considered an informal workspace to support collaborative efforts. A Power BI app isn't necessary for content viewers because the primary use of this workspace is collaboration by a small group of people who work closely together. Most team members have permission to edit content in this workspace.

To backup, the best choice is to copy and paste the Power BI Reports to some other workspace. service-datasets-copy-reports Then recreate a new dashboard in other workspace. You can also try the tool of

the third party platform, but it does not seem to be free:

Update Power BI Admin settings to allow security group to use Power BI APIs; Add Service Principal to Power BI Workspace; Create a flow in Power Automate or Azure Logic Apps to orchestrate the backup; Create App Registration. The app registration created in this step will be used to authenticate against Power BI's API.

User A create a workspace and share to B (so B is also admin now) then if User A's account is deleted, then the workspace is also disappeared, so even B has admin authroity, the workspace would still delete when User A's account doesn't exist. So it can't really fulfill the backup needs...

The Power BI desktop designer is still where all the action happens when it comes to data modeling, adding measures and drawing visuals. The Power BI service allows the designer to share their artifacts in a public workspace or in an app. This means that the administrator will be managing more objects in the service.

Users without a Pro or Premium Per User (PPU) license can access a workspace if the workspace is in a Power BI Premium capacity, but only if they have the Viewer role. Allow users to export data : Even users with the Viewer role in the workspace can export data if they have Build permission on the semantic models in that workspace.

The Microsoft 365 service account used to handle the backup must be assigned the Global administrator role and the Fabric administrator role. The service account must also have a proper license: Power BI Pro or Power BI Premium - depending on the type of workspaces that will be backed up. Create a Power BI connector

In order to backup your reports, Power BI Sentinel needs somewhere to store them, and as you don't want your sensitive data leaving your organization, you need to have your own storage.
