However, most people consider running their hot tub on a generator because of a power outage. The hot tub has full foam insulation, which will help maintain the water temperature.

A whole-house generator, or standby generator, functions by providing automatic backup power to an entire home during power outages. It's integrated into your home's electrical system and usually runs on natural gas or propane. When the generator detects a power disruption, it activates automatically.

- If you need lots of backup power for all your house appliances and big draw items like a hot tub, wine cellar, Air Conditioning, or if you often need backup power, then you're better off with a traditional gas generator. - If your need for backup power is occasional and modest, then a CarGenerator is a better choice.
