Publications Publication 52 Revision: New Mailing Standards for Lithium Batteries . Effective March 2, 2015, the Postal Service(TM) will revise Publication 52, Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail, in various sections to provide new standards for the mailing of lithium batteries.. These revisions were initially announced via a notice in the Federal Register on January 26, ...

USPS ® is the only shipping company that ships cremated remains (human or pet ashes). You may ship cremated remains internationally (if the destination country permits) but must use Priority Mail Express International ® and the appropriate customs form. You are required to use a properly sealed funeral urn as the inner primary container.

According to the US Department of Transportation, there have been over 300 documented incidents involving lithium batteries carried as cargo or baggage since 1991, resulting in fires, explosions, and injuries (Source: US DOT). In one alarming example, a lithium battery caught fire in a UPS cargo plane in 2010, causing the aircraft to crash and killing both pilots ...

Mailpieces containing only button-cell batteries installed in equipment, or no more than four lithium cells or two lithium batteries installed in equipment they operate, (i.e., cell phones, tablets, digital readers, or glucose monitors, etc.) are not required to bear the lithium-battery mark, domestically, when no more than two mailpieces are ...

Air shipments, including Priority Mail and Priority Mail Express, can include a maximum of 2 batteries or 8 cells when they contain standalone lithium ion cells or batteries, or lithium cells or batteries packed with or contained in equipment.

Sending lithium batteries through the mail can sometimes be difficult, because you don't know what you can or cannot ship through the mail. If you've got a laptop that needs to be sent in for repairs or want to mail a new pair of Bluetooth headphones to your grandkids, you can keep reading to learn everything you need to know about USPS' lithium battery policy.

Similar to Priority Mail, ... However, when it comes to cell phones, lithium-ion batteries are installed within the equipment they power, so USPS won't restrict you to ground transportation. When you ship with USPS, you can ship a phone with any air-based service, such as First Class Package. ...

When shipping lithium ion batteries, you'll need to affix special labeling to the outside of your package. When using an air transportation service like Priority Mail, you'll need the UN3481 Lithium Battery Handling Label. Sometimes, you may need to ship with a ground-based service, like when the lithium ion batteries are separate from the ...

"The interim final rule restricts the mail class that may be utilized when shipping pre-owned, damaged or defective electronic devices containing or packaged with lithium batteries (such as cell phones, tablets, laptops, cameras, power tools, etc.) to USPS Retail Ground, Parcel Select, Parcel Return Service or Ground Return Service, and ...

You cannot mail lithium-ion batteries to Canada or Mexico. And you cannot mail any type of battery that is damaged or leaking. Shipping batteries internationally can be a complicated process. There are several restrictions that must be followed in order to ensure safe transport. In addition, each country has its own regulations for shipping ...

If not, securely package your item using non-Priority Mail shipping materials (USPS does not permit the use of Priority Mail shipping materials to ship a Ground Advantage shipment) and attach your shipping label to the box. Once complete, drop off your package at USPS or schedule a free USPS pickup. To ship electronics containing or packed with a lithium battery:

USPS Priority Mail is frequently transported via aircraft, depending on distance between the source and destination. Surprisingly, I have received Li-ion batteries from well known battery and flashlight sellers, that lack the required hazmat label on the package. However, Amazon and Battery Junction have had the proper label in my experience.

Fires caused by lithium batteries, whether shipped alone or within electronics, have been on the rise, causing damage to property and life. ... Refunds for domestic Priority Mail Express will not be available for shipments containing hazardous materials if the item is delivered or delivery was attempted within three days of the date of mailing ...
