# Recycle lithium batteries best buy

State retailers are required to accept a used automotive battery with purchase of a new one. Do not place on curb or in carts for pick-up. Lithium single-use and button-cell batteries. Single-use, long-lasting lithium batteries will be labeled "Lithium" or "Li". They should not be confused with rechargeable "Lithium-Ion (Li-Ion)" batteries.

The state recycling law requires battery retailers to post a sign stating "Recycle Automotive Batteries Here." The sign must be 8.5 x 11 inches and be visible to customers. Resources for retailers. Check for the word "lithium" marked on the battery. Do not put button-cell, coin, or lithium single-use batteries in the trash or municipal recycling bins. Shipping is one way you can recycle batteries. Lithium-ion batteries and consumer devices can be shipped following Department of Transportation (DOT) guidelines to: Redwood Consumer Program, 675 Innovation Way ATTN: Consumer Recycling Program, Sparks, NV 89437.

Rechargeable batteries can be properly recycled at major retailers (e.g., Lowe's, Best Buy, The Home Depot) that participate in the Call2Recycle program. The program is free to residents and accepts Lithium Ion (Li-ion), Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel-Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), and Nickel Zinc (Ni-ZN) as well as small lead-acid batteries.

Yes, lithium batteries can be recycled under the definition of solid waste recycling exclusion at 40 CFR 261.4(a)(24) and/or 40 CFR 261.4(a)(25) (for recycling occurring domestically and after export, respectively) as long as (1) both the state that the batteries are generated in and the state in which the recycling takes place have adopted ...
