Over the past decade, North Carolina has been a national leader in solar energy deployment. Most of the solar energy capacity built in North Carolina has come from utility scale facilities constructed and financed by private solar companies, which have created thousands of jobs and invested a combined \$7.5 billion, mostly in

Capacity of the Largest Solar Power Plant in North Carolina. The largest solar power plant in North Carolina is the Albermarle Beach Solar project in Roper, which has a capacity of 150.6 MW. This project was developed by SunEnergy and became operational in 2020, providing electricity for approximately 17,988 homes.

There are several government incentives and financing programs available to help offset the costs of solar development in North Carolina: The federal Investment Tax Credit (ITC) provides a 30% tax credit for solar projects. ... NC, and supported the company's goal of sourcing 100% renewable energy for its operations.

Generally, for a 2-5 MW solar farm, the development takes 8-14 months. However, the development timeline largely depends on the utility company's interconnection process and, local/municipal permitting and approval processes. Construction can take an additional 5-10 months depending on construction timing based on seasonal considerations.
