

Does Ireland have a high solar capacity?

Is Ireland getting more solar power?

According to the 2024 Scale of Solar report from the Irish Solar Energy Association (ISEA), there has been an almost 43 per cent increase in Ireland's solar power generation capacity, and a huge driver of this has been the residential sector.

Is Ireland in the throes of a solar revolution?

Within a relatively short period, solar has become the country's fastest-growing renewable power source. Almost 60,000 residential homes have solar panels on their rooftops - and 500 houses are being connected to the grid every week.

Will increasing solar capacity increase electricity generation in Ireland?
