RCRA's goals are to protect us from the hazards of waste disposal; conserve energy and natural resources by recycling and recovery; reduce or eliminate waste; and clean up waste that which may have spilled, leaked ...

The 1990 Georgia Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Act requires local governments to complete and periodically update a solid waste management plan. In 1991, Gwinnett County and many of the municipalities within the County developed a state-approved solid waste management plan. A 2007 amendment addresses a 2005 - 2020 planning period.
