The Akou Energy-Tonga 2 - Battery Energy Storage System is a 6,000kW energy storage project located in Tongatapu, Tonga. The rated storage capacity of the project is 23,400kWh. The project was announced in 2019 and will be commissioned in 2021.

In May 2002 Clay Energy commissioned the first off-grid solar base station power system for Vodafone Fiji, which led to the rollout of these power systems to six mobile operators in the region. Clay Energy's first PV grid-connect system (18kW) was installed and commissioned in 2008, being the first in the region.

To achieve its goal of 50% renewable energy by 2020 and 70% by 2030, Tonga is also developing wind and biomass generation sources and will integrate these with multiple units of battery energy storage. ADB is supporting this transition to a cleaner and more sustainable energy mix through a \$12.2 million grant to the Tonga Renewable Energy Project.

Battery Energy Storage Systems are a vital component to reaching Tonga's 50% Renewable Energy target by end of year 2020. Battery Energy storage systems will be able to store renewable energy generated from our existing solar and wind generation sites and distribute it to the people of Tonga when required.

Both individual systems comprise Akuo's Storage GEM modular containerised solution, three for Tonga 1 and five for Tonga 2. Tonga 1 is a 9.3MW/5.3MWh designed to improve grid stability, with a duration of just 34 minutes. Tonga 2 is a 3.3-hour system with 7.2MW/23.9MWh of energy, designed primarily for load shifting.

French renewable power producer Akuo Energy said Friday it has secured a contract to build in Tonga an energy storage system with a capacity of 23.4 MWh/6 MW. The company will be in charge of the engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) of the Tonga 2 facility under a contract signed in November with grid operator Tonga Power Ltd.

Their undertaking is part of the Tonga Renewable Energy Project, which seeks the help the island nation achieve its 70% renewables target by 2030. The new assignment follows a recent announcement that the partners have won a joint bid to build solar arrays, battery storage and distribution networks on outer islands of Tonga.

The Department of Energy under the Ministry of MEIDECC is collaborating with development partners to monitor ongoing projects and implement new programmes to help the country reach its ambitious targets.

The two battery storage facilities installed in Tonga are complementary: the aim of the first 5 MWh / 10 MW battery is to improve the electricity grid's stability (regulating the voltage and frequency), while the second 23 MWh / 7 MW battery is designed to transfer the electrical load in order to help the grid supply electricity at peak times, and notably in the evening.

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The Ha Mai Solar Facility is the first solar farm installed at Lifuka, Ha"apai. It has a capacity of 550 kW and 660 kW/hr of battery storage. Ha"apai is the first island in Tonga to reach 50% renewable energy, another step towards Tonga's overall goal of ...

The ADB worked with Tonga on the development of a hybrid minigrid on Vava"u in 2023, including a 0.3 MW solar generation system and a 1 MW/2 MWh battery energy storage system. That same year, a \$6 million minigrid project serving four islands in the Ha"apai group was commissioned.

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has agreed to part-fund a US\$53.2 million undertaking to power Tonga with renewable energy, including the installation of 22.2MWh of energy storage.
