Utility and network operators RheinEnergie and Bayernwerk have respectively started building and commissioned 7MWh battery storage projects in Germany. Utility RheinEnergie announced last week (24 July) the start of construction on a 32MW solar PV, 7MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) project in the northern state of Mecklenburg-Vorpommern.

According to GreenCo, the implementation of the pilot project is expected to create 600 jobs in the short term and 20 more in the long term. More importantly, the development of battery storage is expected to catalyze renewable energy ...

Turkey's YEO is partnering with Zambian sustainable energy company GEI Power to develop a 60 MW/20 MWh solar plant with battery storage in Choma district, southern Zambia. The facility has been touted as Zambia's first solar plant with battery storage. Valued at approximately \$65 million, it is scheduled to reach commercial operations in September 2025 ...

German renewables firm BayWa r.e. has commissioned a combined PV and battery system in Zambia's Chisamba province, to supply irrigation for aquacultural farming. The feasibility study will devise technical and financial recommendations for the project, which combines 200 megawatts of solar energy generation capacity with battery energy storage. Zambia faces an electricity shortage due to rising demand and reduced hydropower generation, linked to climate change.

The project would also "place Zambia at the centre of renewable energy trading across southern Africa" through the Southern Africa Power Pool (SAAP), the international power grid between a dozen countries in southern Africa. That pilot project will then inform an expanded 400MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) rollout across the country.

As with the Moss Landing Energy Storage Facility in California -- at 400MW/1,600MWh currently the world's biggest BESS project and brought online last year -- the battery module supplier was LG Energy Solution. Burns & McDonnell also worked on Moss Landing and said it worked closely with the battery company to coordinate project design as ...

It is envisaged that the solar plant, to be built on a 250-hectare site, will also include a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) with a minimum capacity of 5 MW and a maximum capacity of 10 MW. Transmission lines will be built to connect to the Mwenda Zesco substation 29 km away, as well as a solar plant at the Luongo Mine, located 22 km away.
